Re: Leaving Certificate Examinations 2021

Dear 6th Year Students & Parents/Guardians,

We wish all of our 6th Year students, who are sitting exams the very best of luck and we know they will do very well given all of the hard work they have put into their studies.

We have already spoken to our 6th Year students about the examination arrangements, but we wish to give them some reminders before the commencement of the examinations tomorrow.

All 6th yrs should be in their assigned seat in the exam centre 30 mins before the start time of examinations on day 1 and at least 15 mins in advance of their examinations on subsequent days. **Mobile phones should be placed in the lockers provided - Students should remember to bring a lock and key.**

Candidates should not present for examination if they are:

- diagnosed with COVID-19
- Unwell and have any symptoms at any stage over the course of the examinations
- are self isolating or have been instructed to self isolate
- are quarantining or otherwise restricting their movements
- are a close contact of a confirmed case

At the examination centre candidates must,

- observe 2 metres social distancing and minimise their interactions
- Wear an appropriate face covering(i.e a face mask covering the nose and mouth at all times while on the school premises)
- Practice good respiratory etiquette and hand hygiene
- Comply with all other Public Health measures put in place for the examinations
- Avoid mingling with other candidates in advance of the start of the examinations, between examinations and departing the examination centre each day

Each exam centre will have an assigned room for study/lunch. These assigned rooms will be on the examination noticeboard in the school. **Students must eat their**
